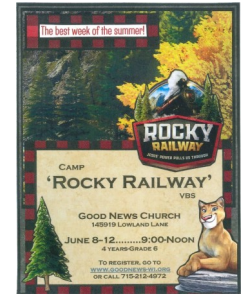


Last week would have been our regularly scheduled Rummage Sale; however, it has been postponed until September.
