Dear Good News:

This Sunday, May 24th, will be our last streaming only service.

The Elders and Pastors are pleased to announce the addition of face-to-face services beginning on Sunday, May 31st at 10:00 am.


There will be two options with our services: a live, in-person service with two designated sections of the worship center, one with masks required and another where masks are optional; and our streaming, at-home option.

- 1) Live, in-person, mask optional seating during the service in the worship center. Seating will be by household unit with appropriate (six feet) spacing between families. All attending will be required to be symptom-free, being able to attest to the screening questions below; **masks are optional**. **NOTE:** Please enter and leave the church through the main entrance. The main entrance restrooms will be open for those attending worship in the worship center. Please park on the south or west side of the church building.
- 2) Live, in-person, mask required seating in the worship center (please see picture below). Seating will be by household unit with appropriate (six feet) spacing between families preferred. All seated in the area will be required to be symptom-free, being able to attest to the screening questions below; **masks are required**. **NOTE:** Enter and leave the church through the youth entrance. The youth hallway restrooms will be open for those seated in this area. Please park on the east side of the church building.
- 3) Streaming, at home, will continue consistent with the last several weeks.

Mask only section – Come in the east (Youth Room Entrance), sit on the east side of the sanctuary. The rest of the sanctuary is mask optional. Thank you!

For those attending face to face services please note the following:

- By attending, you acknowledge you have reviewed the symptoms attestation below and have answered “No” to all the

questions before entering the church. If you can answer “Yes” to one or more of these questions, you agree not to attend in person; stay home if you are ill.

- There will be no Sunday School.
- No children’s church will be provided. Family units are encouraged to bring their own video or entertainment systems (e.g., streaming RightNow media with headphones) or activities for younger children during the service.
- There will be no coffee served, nor will drinking fountains be available.
- A limited supply of hand sanitizer stations and masks will be available for use; however, we encourage you to bring your own as needed.
- No bulletins will be handed out (announcements and note pages will be available on-line).
- The offering plate will not be passed. Instead, an offering box will be available in the back of the worship center. On-line giving is encouraged, please see the “Giving” heading on the goodnews-wi.org website.
- Worship songs. We will remain seated for songs; unmasked individuals are asked not to sing out. The worship will be more contemplative / meditative as led by Pastor Knight.
- Fellowship. We look forward for opportunities to fellowship before and after service. Please maintain appropriate social distances (6 ft). Weather permitting, we encourage fellowship outside of the Church building when possible.

Sunday Screening Questions Prior to Your Attending:

Do you have a temperature greater than 100.0 °F (37.8 °C)?

Do you have a new or worsening:

- Cough?
- Shortness of breath?
- Headache?
- Body or muscle aches or soreness (not related to over-exertion)?
- Fatigue?
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea?
- Loss of smell or taste?

(all not related to an already existing condition)

Have you had close, unprotected contact (within 6 feet for 10 minutes or more without a facemask) with a person who you know is positive for COVID-19 within the past 14 days?

If you answered “Yes” to one or more of these questions, do not attend Church in person, stay home. If symptoms persist, contact your primary care provider.

If you answered “NO” to all questions, you are cleared to attend Church in person.
